## Trivia... did you know?

As Saskatoon and Rosewood grows in 2014 we welcome those residents who have come from other areas of Saskatchewan, Canada, and beyond.

Here are a few bits of trivia you may or may not know:

- Saskatoon is located in the Moist Mixed Grassland Eco-region, notable for a lack of large native trees, an abundance of prairie pothole wetlands, and some of the richest farmland in North America.
- Saskatchewan occupies an area known as the central flyway, which extends from the Gulf Coast of Texas northward to the Northwest Territories. This flyway is used by many species of waterfowl, shorebirds, and waterbirds, as an annual migration route in the spring and fall. Listen and look overhead in the spring and fall to see large flocks of geese and cranes as they travel between breeding and wintering grounds.
- Saskatoon is one of the top five sunniest major cities in Canada, recording an average of 2,329 hours of sunlight annually.
- Saskatoon has 200 parks and nearly 1,000 hectares of parkland throughout the city, (including nearly 30 hectares in the Rosewood community!) and almost 160 hectares of river valley parkland.
